

Mr. Heath reported a bill entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act incorporating the Baltimore second dispensary, which was read the first, and by special order a second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

On motion, the bill to authorise and empower the justices of the levy court of Charles county, to fix and regulate the rates of public inns, and the bill to authorise and empower the levy court of Frederick county, to levy a sum of money, and to erect an engine and hose house, in Frederick-town, were ordered to lie on the table.

The bill for the relief of Priscilla North, of Somerset county, was read a third time, passed, and returned to the house of delegates.

The bill to divorce Lucinda D. Lusby, and her husband Thomas R. Lusby, of the city of Baltimore, was read a third time, passed, and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Johnson, from the committee to whom was referred, the bill for the opening of monument street, in the city of Baltimore, reported the same, with the following amendments, viz: 1st, Strike out "&c." in the 17th line, of the 5th section, and insert "and the other necessary costs."—2d, Strike out the words, "first day of April next," in the 2d line, 7th section, and insert, "expiration of one month after the appointment, of this act, by the mayor and city council of Baltimore, as hereinafter provided for."—3d, Strike out the same words in the 7th line, same section, and insert "expiration of one month after such approval of the mayor and city council aforesaid." 4th, At the end of the bill, add as an additional section, the following, viz—"And be enacted, that this act shall be of no force or validity, unless approved of by the mayor and city council of Baltimore." Which amendments were read and assented to.—The bill was then read a second, and by special order a third time, passed, and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr Johnson, from the committee to whom was referred, the bill for the opening of Ensor street, in the city of Baltimore, reported the same, with the following amendments, viz:—1st Strike out the words, "first day of April next," in the 2d line of the 7th section, and insert, "expiration of one month after the approval of this act, by the mayor and city council of Baltimore, as is hereinafter provided."—2d, Strike out the same words, viz:—"first day of April next," in the 6th, and 7th lines, same section, and insert "expiration of one month after the approval of this act, by the mayor and city council aforesaid."—3d, Add as an additional section, the following, "And be it enacted, That this act shall be of no force or validity, unless approved of by the mayor and city council of Baltimore."—Which amendments were read and assented to—The bill was then read a second, and by special order, the third time, passed, and returned to the house of delegates.
