

The bill entitled, an act to facilitate the collection of taxes due upon lands in Charles county, belonging to non-resident proprietors, was read the second time.

The bill entitled, an act to provide for completing the records in the office of register of wills for Charles county, was read a second time, and referred to Messrs. Herbert, Marriott and Forrest.

On motion, the bill to open Pine street, in the city of Baltimore, was ordered to lie on the table.

The bill entitled, an act to authorise and empower the levy court of Frederick county, to levy a sum of money and re-build a bridge over Monocacy on the road leading from Tany-town, to Emmitsburg, was read a second time.

On motion, the bill to provide for altering the grade of Fayette street, in the city of Baltimore, between Paca and Cove street, was ordered to lie on the table.

The supplement to the act entitled, an act to incorporate the president and directors of the Firemen's Insurance company of Baltimore, was read the second time.

The bill supplementary to the act incorporating a company to introduce a copious supply of water into the town of Emmitsburg, in Frederick county, was read a second, and by special order a third time, passed, and returned to the house of delegates.

The bill to alter the time of the meeting of the general assembly of this state, and for other purposes, was read a second time.

On motion of Mr. Lloyd, the further consideration of the said bill was indefinitely postponed.

The clerk of the house of delegates delivered a resolution relative to the claim of Honorable Jeremiah Townly Chase, against the state, which was read the first time.

Also, a resolution in favour of Ann Hollydyoak, of the city of Annapolis, which was read the first time, and referred to the committee on pensions and revolutionary claims.

Also, a bill entitled, an act to change the name of William Connelly, of Dorchester county, to that of William Smoot, which was read the first time.

Also, a bill entitled, a further supplement to the act entitled, an act to establish a bank and incorporate a company, under the name of the Cumberland Bank of Alleghany, which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Kennedy, Nelson, and Harrison.

Also, a bill entitled, an act to alter the mode of appointing commissioners of the tax for Somerset county, which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Dennis, Whiteley and Rees.
