Also, a bill to authorise the levy court of Caroline County, to build a bridge and open certain roads in said county, and for other purposes, which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Whiteley, Marriott and Johnson.

Also, a bill entitled, an act authorising Elizabeth R. Howard, of Montgomery county, to convey a certain lot of land therein mentioned, which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Forrest, Nelson and Heath.

Also, a bill entitled, an act for the benefit of Hester Whitaker and others, the heirs and representatives of Alexander Whitaker, of Montgomery county, deceased, which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Forrest Harrison and Marriott.

Also, a bill entitled, an act to change the road and divisional line, between Queen Anns and Caroline counties, which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Whiteley, Harrison and Johnson.

Also, a bill entitled, an act for the relief of Jacob Getzendanner, of Frederick county, which was read the first time.

Also, a bill entitled, an act to provide for electing commissioners for Baltimore county, and prescribing their powers and duties, which was read the first time.

Also, a bill entitled, an act to provide for the printing and publishing of the laws of this state, which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Heath, Marriott and Johnson.

Also, a bill entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, 'an act to amend and reduce into one the several acts of assembly relating to the public roads in Worcester county, passed at November session 1821, which was read the first time,

And returned the bill entitled, a further supplement to the act entitled, an act for the better regulation of apprentices, and the bill entitled, an act relating to division fences between different proprietors, in Anne Arundel county, severally endorsed, 'will pass.'

Also, the bill to abolish all such parts of the constitution and form of Government as relate to the time and manner of electing the senate, and the mode of filling up vacancies in that body, so that each county and the city of Baltimore, may have a senator to be elected immediately by the people, with the following message which was read.
