The resolution authorising the governor and council to grant a commission of Lieutenant Colonel, to the military professor in Saint Johns College, was read, assented to, and returned to the house of delegates.

The additional supplement to the act concerning crimes and punishments, was read the second and third time, passed, and returned to the house of delegates.

The clerk of the house of delegates delivered the following messages, which were read.

By the House of Delegates, March 12th, 1827. Gentlemen of the Senate,

The bill entitled, "an act to incorporate the Etna Iron company in the city of Baltimore, has been returned from your honorable body, endorsed, "will not pass."—We send you the said bill a second time, and respectfully request that you will again consider it, and if consistent with your ideas of propriety, pass the same.

Also, a resolution requiring the board of public works to assume the payment of 100 dollars to the commissioners under the act incorporating the Susquehannah and Patapsco canal company, which was read and assented to, and returned to the house of delegates.
