Mr. Kennedy offered the following resolution.

'Resolved, that the governor and council be, and they are hereby authorised and empowered to employ three fit and proper persons well acquainted with the laws and customs of the state, to prepare a general insolvent system, suitable for the state to adopt, and that the executive cause the same to be laid before the legislature at the commencement of its next session.—Which was read the first, second, and third times, and dissented from.

The resolution relating to a tract of land in Harford county referred to in resolution No. 45, passed at December session 1824, was read and assented to, and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Sewell reported favourably on the resolution in favour of Jane Beatty of Pittsburg, Pennsylvania; the said resolution was thereupon read and assented to, and returned to the house of delegates.

The resolution authorising the treasurer of the western shore to credit the account of John Clare, former sheriff of Calvert county, with the interest therein mentioned, was read and assented to, and returned to the house of delegates.

The report and resolution submitted by the committee directed by an order of the house of delegates to inquire into the expediency of heating the apartments of the state house in some manner more safe and comfortable than the mode now used; was read, assented to, and returned to the house of delegates.

The act supplementary to an act passed at November session seventeen hundred and ninety seven, chapter eleven, was read, passed with the following amendment and returned to the house of delegates.

Strike out all the bill after the word 'extended,' in the 4th line of the section, and insert, 'to the city of Baltimore, as the bounds and limits of that city are at present extended.

The bill supplemental to an act passed at December session 1825, chapter 199, was read, passed, and returned to the house of delegates.

The bill to divorce Rebecca Thrush and her husband Nicholas Thrush of the city of Baltimore, was read, rejected, and returned to the house of delegates.

The bill making certain chancery records therein mentioned, evidence, was read, passed, and returned to the house of delegates.

The bill to authorise and empower the justices of the levy court of Charles county to fix and regulate the rates of public inns, was read, rejected, and returned to the house of delegates.
