Saturday, 5th January, 1828

The Senate met. Present the Same members as on yesterday. Mr. Rees appeared in the Senate.

The proceedings of yesterday were read.

The clerk of the House of Delegates delivered a resolution providing for the payment of the members and officers of the present General Assembly, which was read the first and by special order the second and third time, assented to and returned to the House of Delegates.

Also a bill entitled, an act to repeal an act entitled, an act to exempt the servants of overseers of the county roads in Dorchester County from doing duty on said roads, passed December session eighteen hundred and twenty-six, chapter ten, also a bill, entitled, an act to confirm the name of Lucia Tall Traverse, of Dorchester County which were severally read the first time and laid on the table.

On motion, by Mr. Herbut, the following order was read and unanimously adopted. Ordered, that it be now noted on the Journal, that the entry made in the Journal of the last session on the 12th day of March, in these words in Mr. Dennis then withdrew from the Senate Chamber. was unauthorised.

The Senate then adjourned until Monday morning, ten o'clock.

Monday, 6th January, 1828.

The senate met. Present the same members as on Saturday. Mr. Johnson and Mr. Lloyd appeared in the senate.

The proceedings of Saturday were read.
