

county so that each district and the city of Annapolis may have one member, which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Heath, Sewell and Herbert.

Also, a bill entitled, an act to authorise the Levy Court of Frederick county to keep in repair a road therein mentioned, which was read the first time & referred to Messrs. Nelson, Dennis and Forrest.

Also a bill entitled an act to make void a certain deed of manumission, which was read the first time and referred to Messrs Forrest, Thomas and Dennis.

Also a bill entitled a supplement to the act entitled, an act relative to justices of the peace and for other purposes passed at December session, 1815, chapter 82, which was read, the first time.

Also a bill entitled, a further supplement to an act entitled an act relating to justices of the peace in the city of Baltimor passed at December session. 1818, a chapter 209 which was read the first time and referred to Messrs Heath Thomas and Harrison.

And returned the bill to extend to Worcester county the provisions of the act of Assembly, entitled an act, to define certain trespasses-felony, and and for other purposes, endorsed "will pass."

The resolution relative to the state library was read a second time, and amended by inserting the number "three" as the number of which the committee on the part of the senate should consist."

The resolution was then read a third time by special order, and assented to.

Mr. Heath then offered the following message, which was read.

By the Senate, January 17th, 1828.

Gentlemen of the House of Delegates,

The Senate have received your message relating to the state library, with the accompanying resolution. We have amended the latter by filling the blank left by your house. If your honorable body shall adopt the amendment, the committee on the part of the senate will consist of Messrs. ——— and ——— and ———.

On motion, the senate proceeded to fill the blanks contained in the said message. When the names of Messrs Marriott, Pest Heath and Dennis were inserted. The message was then read and assented to.

The clerk of the house of Delegates delivered a bill, entitled,
