

Mr. Heath from the committee made a favorable report upon the bill for the appointment of trustees for the sale of the real estate of Thomas Gorsuch late of Baltimore county; the said bill was then read a second time.

The additional supplement to the act for founding an university in the city or precincts of Baltimore, by the name of the university of Maryland, was read a third time by special order, passed and sent to the house of delegates.

Mr. Kennedy from the committee made a favorable report upon the bill entitled, a supplement to the act for the more effectual protection of public worship in this state, passed at December session 1824, chapter 53; the said bill was then read a second time and recommitted.

Mr. Heath asked and obtained leave to bring in a bill to be entitled, a supplement to the act entitled, an act to amend and reduce into one system the laws to direct descents—Ordered, that Messrs Heath, Forrest and Harrison be a committee to prepare and report the same.

Mr. Dennis asked and obtained leave to bring in a bill to be entitled, an act further to regulate the proceedings in the court of chancery, and of the several county courts of this state setting as courts of equity - Ordered, that Messrs. Dennis, Nelson and Herbert be a committee to prepare and report the same.

Mr. Dennis from the committee, reported said bill, which was read the first time, and ordered to be printed,

The president laid before the senate a communication from the treasurer of the western shore, enclosing a report and account of the managers of the Washington Monument, made in obedience to the act of December session 1824, chapter 125, section 2, which was read and referred to the consideration of the house of delegates.

The clerk of the house of delegates delivered a resolution in favor of John H. Hays of St. Mary's county, which was read and referred to the committee on pensions and revolutionary claims.
