

Mr. Thomas, from the committee of ways and means, to whom was referred the preamble and resolutions in favour of Thomas Baldwin and Samuel Scott, Jr. of Prince George's County, reported favorably on said preamble and resolution, which was read the second and by special order the third time, and on motion they were ordered to lie on the table.

Mr. Dennis, from the committee on invalid deeds to whom was referred the bill entitled, an act to confirm and make valid two deeds therein mentioned, reported unfavorably on said bill. The bill was then read the second and by special order the third time, and on motion it was ordered to lie on the table.

Mr. Lloyd, from the committee to whom was referred the bill entitled, a further supplement to the act entitled, an act concerning crimes and punishments, reported unfavorably on said bill, the bill was then read the second time.

On motion, by Mr. Harrison, the committee to whom was referred the petition of Henry Hindman of Queen Anne's County, was enlarged by the addition of the names of Mr. Lloyd and Mr. Sewell.

On motion the Senate proceeded to the consideration of the preamble and resolution in favour of Thomas Baldwin and Samuel Scott, Jr. of Prince George's County, and on the question being put, "will the Senate assent to the same." It was determined in the affirmative, and the preamble and resolution were returned to the House of Delegates.

On motion, the senate proceeded to the consideration of the bill, entitled, an act to confirm and make valid two deeds therein mentioned, and on the question being put, "shall the bill pass," it was determined in the negative, and the bill was returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Thomas from the committee on Ways and Means, to whom was referred the resolution in favor of Samuel Mearns, reported favorably thereon. The resolution was then read the second and third time by special order, assented to and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Harrison from the committee to whom the petition of Henry Hindman, of Queen Ann's County, was referred, reported a bill entitled, an act to secure Henry Hindman of Queen Ann's County, an annuity in the real estate therein mentioned, which was read the first time.

The bill entitled, a further supplement to the act entitled an act concerning crimes and punishments, was on motion
