

ty, reported favorably on said bill, which was read the second and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates

The clerk of the house of delegates delivered the following bills, to wit:

A bill entitled, an act relating to sales of sheriffs, coroners, elisors and other officers, which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Heath, Herbert and Forrest.

And a bill entitled, an act relating to the public roads in Talbot county, which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Whiteley, Lloyd and Rees.

On motion of Mr. Heath, the senate proceeded to the consideration of the bill entitled, an act to regulate the issuing of licenses to traders, keepers of ordinaries and others, and of the message relating thereto. Mr. Kennedy offered the following as an amendment, to wit:

In the 3d line of the 1st section, strike out the word 'Barter,' which was read, and the question was put, 'will the senate agree that said amendment shall be added to those proposed in the message, relating to said bill. submitted by the committee on ways and means?' Determined in the negative.

Mr. Kennedy also offered the following as an amendment, to wit: In the 7th and 8th lines of the 1st section, strike out the words "salted provisions, grain, meal, flour, timber, tobacco, cotton, leather, hides, lime," which was read; the same question was about to be put on this amendment, as on the first, when the yeas and nays being asked for, were taken and appeared as follows:
