

7th. In the 24th line of the 5th section, after the word 'them,' strike out all that follows of that section.

8th. In the 7th line of the 7th section, after the word 'Maryland,' strike out all that follows of the section, and insert in lieu thereof the following, by action of debts or indictment in the county court of the county where such offence shall have been committed, or in Baltimore city court if the offence shall have been committed within the limits of said city.

9th. At the end of the 12th section add the following proviso.

'Provided however, that the said repeal shall be construed to prevent the issuing of licenses under the said act, or acts to be in force, until the first day of May next; and for which there shall be paid such sum of money for the time that such license is to continue as shall be in just proportion to the sum required by said act, or acts for a license for an entire year.
