Messrs. Sewell and Whiteley, having waited on the speaker and members of the house of delegates, returned to the senate chamber and informed the president of the senate that they had performed the duty assigned them.

Whereupon the speaker attended by the members of the house of delegates, appeared in the senate chamber, when the engrossed bills from number 1 to number 93 inclusive, were presented by the speaker of the house of delegates to his Excellency the Governor, who signed and sealed the same, in the presence of both houses, in accordance to the provisions of the constitution and form of government.

The speaker and members of the house of delegates having retired.

The Senate adjourned until to-morrow morning ten o'clock.

The Senate met. Present the same members as on yesterday.

The proceedings of yesterday were read.

The bill to empower the judges of Montgomery County Court to direct the sale of the land therein mentioned, was read a third time, passed, and sent to the house of delegates.

Mr. Whiteley from the committee to whom was referred the bill to authorise the levy court of Caroline county to make sale of part of the public land in the village of Denton in said county, heretofore amended and passed by the Senate, and returned from the house of delegates with a request that the amendment might be receded from, reported that the committee were of opinion that the amendment which is as follows, should be receded from, and that the bill should pass in its original form. Add the following as an additional section, 'And be it enacted, that if at any time thereafter, those who originally owned the land on which said front street was situated at the time said highway was condemned, or their heirs or assigns, shall deem themselves aggrieved by any provision in this act, they or either of them may apply to the levy court of Caroline county to appoint three Commissioners to appraise such damage, and said Commissioners shall return such
