

3d. Before the word "repair" in same line insert the words "keep in."

4th. After the word "repair" in same line insert the following, viz: "All that part of the road located as the Westminster and Hager's-Town turnpike road, which commences at the termination of five miles thereof in John Smith's lane, and runs westward through Union-Town to a point near John Grammar's house."

5th. In the last line of the 1st-section strike out the words "two miles" and insert in lieu thereof the word "part"

6th. After the word "of" in same line insert the word "the"

7th. In the 3d line of the 2d section strike out the words "at the rate of"

8th. In the same line before the word "half" strike out the word "at"

9th. After the word "construed" in the 2d line of the 3d section insert the word "as."

Which amendments were read and assented to.

The said bill was then read a second, and by special order a third time, and passed with the proposed amendments.

The senate adjourned until to-morrow morning ten o'clock.

SATURDAY, January 15, 1831.

The senate met. Present the same members as on yesterday.

The proceedings of yesterday were read.

The bill, entitled, An act to prevent swine and geese going at large in Middle-Town, Grove's Addition and Keller's Addition to Middle-Town, in Frederick county was read the third time and passed.

The clerk of the house of delegates delivered a bill, entitled, An act to authorise the recording of the will of Christian Wyandt, late of Washington county; which was read the first time and referred to the committee on invalid deeds.

Also a bill, entitled, An act to encourage the destruction of crows in Kent county; which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Rees, Spence and Harrison.

And resolutions in favour of Thomas Jenkins, and Benja-
