The senate met. Present the same members as on Saturday. The proceedings of Saturday were read.

The bill, entitled; An act relative to a part of the West-minster and Hagerstown turnpike road, passed by the senate on Friday; the bill, entitled, An act to prevent swine and geese going at large in Middletown, Grove's Addition and Keller's Addition to Middletown, in Frederick county, passed by the senate on Saturday; the bill, entitled, An act authorising the recording of a deed from Edward G. Williams, late of Washington county, deceased, to Sarah Syester; and the bill, entitled, An act to authorise the clerk of Dorchester county court, to record a deed therein mentioned; severally rejected by the senate on the same day, were returned to the house of delegates.

The bill, entitled, An additional supplement to an act, entitled, A supplement to an act to incorporate the Port Deposit and Chesapeake Turnpike road company, passed at December session 1827, chapter 200; was read the third time, passed as amended, and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Forrest, from the committee, reported a bill, entitled, An additional supplement to the act to prevent the unnecessary accumulation of costs in civil suits; which was read the first time and ordered to be printed.

Mr. Kennedy asked and obtained leave to bring in a bill to be entitled. An act relative to the public buildings at Annapolis. Ordered, That Messrs. Kennedy, Whiteley and Thomas, be a committee to prepare and report the same.

The bill entitled, An act to make valid a certain deed of manumission therein mentioned, upon which a favourable report had been made, was read the third time and rejected.

The senate adjourned until to-morrow morning 10 o'clock.
