

additional supplement to the act, entitled, An act relating to insolvent debtors in the city and county of Baltimore, was read the third time by special order, passed, and sent to the house of delegates.

On motion of Mr. Heath, the bill to confirm an act, entitled, An act to regulate the removal of proceedings in criminal cases, and to make certain changes in the constitution and form of government for that purpose, was read the second time by special order, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

On motion of Mr. Harrison, the senate took up for consideration the bill to authorise the recording of the will of Christian Wyandt, late of Washington county; when

On motion of Mr. Heath, the same was ordered to lie on the table.

The clerk of the council delivered a communication from the executive, enclosing a memorial from the American convention for promoting the abolition of slavery, and improving the condition of the African race, which lately he'd a meeting at the city of Washington; which was read and referred to the consideration of the house of delegates.

Mr. Heath, from the committee, made an unfavourable report upon the bill, entitled, An act to extend the jurisdiction of justices of the peace.

The said bill was then read a second time, and ordered to lie on the table.

On motion of Mr. Heath, the engrossed bill, entitled, An act to authorise Jonas M'Pherson to lease certain property belonging to the minor children of William Allcock, deceased, was read the third time by special order, passed, and sent to the house of delegates.

Mr. Kennedy, from the committee, made an unfavourable report upon the bill, entitled, An act concerning the trial of causes in Washington county court.

The said bill was then read a second, and by special order a third time, rejected; and returned to the house of delegates.

The bill authorising the clerk of Frederick county, to record a deed executed by Peter Frick, of the city and county of Baltimore, conveying certain lands therein mentioned to Peter H. Brown, of Frederick county, was read the third time, rejected, and returned to the house of delegates.

The clerk of the house of delegates delivered a bill, entitled, An act authorising and empowering the commission-
