2d. In the 6th line of the 1st section, strike out the words "erected into."

3d. In the 7th line of same section, strike out the words "in fact and in law."

4th. In the 8th line, strike out the words "American Institute at," and insert after the words "Mount St. Mary's" the word "institute."

5th. In the 11th line of same section, strike out from word "impleaded" to the word "whatever" the latter inclusive, in the 12th line, and insert in lieu thereof the words "in any court of law or equity of this state."

6th. Strike out the proviso to the second section, and insert in lieu thereof the following proviso, viz: "Provided nevertheless, i hat the said corporation hereby created shall not at any one time hold more than one thousand acres of land, nor shall the nett annual income, arising from the estate real; personal or mixed, of said corporation, exceed the sum of ten thousand dollars."

7th. Stride out after the 1st line of the 2d section, the words by the General Assembly of Maryland.

8th. Add the following as an additional section, and number it as section 4. 'And be it enacted that the General Assembly of Maryland shall at all times have, and hereby expressly reserves the power to alter or amend this charter.'

9th. Strike out the title of the bill, and insert the following as the title—"An act to incorporate Mount St. Mary's Institute in Frederick county."

Which amendments were read and assented to.

The said bill was then read a second, and by special order a third time, and passed with the proposed amendments.

The clerk of the house of delegates delivered a bill, entitled. An additional supplement to the act, entitled. An act for the benefit of the University of Maryland; which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Heath, Harrison and Forrest.
