The said resolution was then read a second, and by special order a third time, and assented to.

Mr. Thomas, from the committee, made a favourable report upon the resolution directing the governor and council to appoint two planters from each of the six most extensive to-bacco growing counties in the state, and two shippers of to-bacco, to examine into the condition of the public tobacco warehouses, and the different scites on the basin.
