

On motion of Mr. Heath, the bill, entitled, An act to divorce Richard Gittings and Elizabeth Gittings of the city of Baltimore, was read the third time by special order, and

On motion of Mr. Herbert, was ordered to lie on the table,

Mr. Kennedy, from the committee to whom was referred the bill, entitled, An act to authorise Christian Stonebraker, of Washington county, to remove a negro slave therein mentioned into this state, delivered the following report; which was read and concurred in.

The committee to whom was referred the bill from the house of delegates entitled, An act to authorise Christian Stonebraker, of Washington county, to remove a negro slave therein mentioned into this state, have had the same under their consideration, and as they find the case provided for by the act of assembly passed at December session eighteen hundred and twenty-three, chapter eighty-seven, entitled, A supplement to an act, entitled, A supplement to the act, entitled, An act relative to negroes and slaves, they therefore consider that there is no necessity to pass the bill.

The said bill mentioned in the said report, was then read a second, and by special order a third time, and rejected.

The clerk of the house of delegates delivered a bill, entitled, An act for the benefit of Horatio Clagett, of Alexandria; which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Herbert, Smith and Dennis.

Also a bill, entitled, An act requiring the commissioners of Harford county, to open the road therein mentioned; which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Sewell, Kennedy and Whiteley.

Also a bill, entitled, A supplement to the act, entitled, An act to provide for the payment of jurors of Prince-George's county, passed at December session 1820, chapter 63; which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Herbert, Forrest and Thomas.

And a resolution authorising the treasurer of the Western Shore to pay to Benjamin L. Gantt, for the use of Benjamin Duvall jr. of Prince-George's county, a sum of money therein mentioned; which was read the first time and referred to the committee on ways and means.

And returned the bill, entitled, An act for the relief of Thomas Murphy of Queen-Anne's county, endorsed "will pass with the proposed amendment."
