

Thomas Murphy, clerk of said county, presented to the levy court in the year 1829, and should they find, upon such examination that improper and illegal deductions and abatements have been made therefrom, to certify the amount thereof to the present levy court of said county, whose duty it shall be to levy the same on the assessable property of said county, for the use of the said Thomas Murphy, to be collected as other county charges are."

Which amendment was read and assented to, and the bill ordered to be engrossed.

On motion of Mr. Heath, the engrossed bill, entitled, An act to authorise the recording of a deed therein mentioned, was read a third time by special order and passed.

On motion of Mr. Kennedy, the bill, entitled, An act for the relief of John Barks of Washington county, and Mary Barks of Frederick county, was taken up for consideration, read the third time, and the question put, Shall the bill pass? Determined in the negative.

On motion of Mr. Kennedy, the senate reconsidered their vote in the rejection of the said bill.

On motion of Mr. Kennedy, the said bill was then re-committed.

On motion of Mr. Kennedy, the engrossed bill, entitled, An act to confirm an act passed at December session 1829, chapter 168, was read the third time by special order and passed.

Mr. Herbert, from the committee made a favourable report upon the bill, entitled, An act regulating the manner of levying on the assessable property in Anne-Arundel county for the support of primary schools in said county.

The said bill was then read a second time.

Mr. Herbert, from the committee made an unfavourable report upon the bill, entitled, an act to repeal the fifth section of An act, entitled, An act to regulate the manner of granting out county pensions for Anne-Arundel county, passed at December session 1829, chapter 63.

The said bill was then read a second time.

On motion of Mr. Heath, the engrossed bill, entitled, An act to incorporate the Baltimore Life Insurance Company, was read the third time by special order and passed.

Mr. Forrest, from the committee made a favourable report upon the bill, entitled, An act to distribute the school fund of Montgomery county.

The said bill was then read a second time.
