racing, cock-fighting and betting on elections, in Washings toncounty.

The said bill was then read a second, and by special order a third time, when Mr. Thomas moved that the bill be laid on the table. And the question was put, and determined in the negative.

The question was then put, Shall the bill pass? Determined in the negative.

Mr. Dennis from the committee to whom was referred the bill, entitled, An act for the benefit of the children of Robert J. Henry, late of Worcester county, deceased, reported the same with the following amendments, viz:

Amendments proposed,

1st In the 5th line of the preamble after the word "estate" strike out the word "with" and substitute the word "without"

2d In the 3d line of the 1st section after the word "contract" insert the following words; viz; "Subject to the direction and to the approbation of the orphans court of Worcester county"

3d In the 14th line of same section after the word "estate" insert the following clause: provided the said court shall previous to said receipt approve of the terms of said purchase.

4th In the 19th line of the same section after the word deeds' insert as follows: "to be approved by the said court." Which amendments were read and assented to.

The said bill was then read a second, and by special order a third time, and passed with the proposed amendments.

Mr. Dennis from the committee made a favourable report upon the bill, entitled, An act to repeal an act of assembly, entitled, An act to limit the time for taking appeals from magistrates judgments, passed at December session 1829 chapter 236, and for other purposes.

The said bill was then read a second time.

On motion of Mr. Forrest, the bill, entitled An act to distribute the school fund of Montgomery county, was taken up for consideration, when on motion of Mr. Kennedy it was laid on the table.
