And a resolution in favor of Anna M. Smith; which was read the first time, and referred to the committee on pensions and revolutionary claims.

And the following message, which was read.

The bill, entitled, an act to divorce William W. Vicars, and Rebecca Vickars, of Dorchester county, was read the third time and the question was put, shall the bill pass? Determined in the negative, and the bill returned to the House of Dele-

gates.

On motion of Mr Harrison, the bill entitled an additional supplement to the act entitled, an act to incorporate a company for the purpose of cutting and making a canal between the river Delaware and Chesapeake bay, was taken up for consideration, when on motion of Mr. Heath, it was ordered to lie on the table.

Mr. Herbert appeared in the Senate.

Mr. Dennis, from the committee, made a favorable report upon the bill, entitled, an act to incorporate the Presbyterian Church in Salisbury, in Worcester county.

The said bill was then read a second, and by special order,

a third time and passed.

The clerk of the House of Delegates delivered the following message, which was read.

We respectfully request your honourable body to return to this house for the purpose of amendment, the bill entitled, an act to authorise a subscription to the capital stock of the Baltimore and Susquehannah rail road company."
