The senate met. Present the same members as on yes-erday.

The proceedings of vesterday were read.

The bill entitled, an act for the relief of Susannah Holmes, of Baltimore county, passed by the Senate yesterday, and the resolution in favor of John Rigney of Frederick county, assented to by the Senate on the same day, were returned to the House of Delegates.

The bill, entitled, an act to abolish imprisonment for debt on certain judgments rendered by Justices of the Peace, passed by the Senate on the same day, was sent to the House of Delegates.

The engrossed resolution directing the Executitive to give notice by advertisements for proposals for Printing the deficient proceedings of the Convention, which formed the Constitution of this State, and of the Legislature of the Province and State of Maryland, was read a third time, assented to, and sent to the House of Delegates.

Mr. Dennis, from the committee, made a favorable report upon the bill, entitled, an act to keep in repair the causeway near the town of Salisbury in Somerset county.

The said bill was then read a second, and by special oreder a third time, passed, and returned to the House of Delegates.

On motion of Mr.Smith, the bill, entitled, an act to incorporate a company under the name of the Jefferson Library company, was read a third time by special order, passed, and returned to the House of Delegates.

Mr. Smith from the committee, to which was referred the bill, entitled, an act prescribing the duties of the several Armourers of this State, reported the same with the rollowing amendments, viz—

Amendments proposed:

In 3d line of 6th section, strke out the words, "where the case may happen."
