Mr. Dennis moved to amend the message, by striking out the words "Saturday the 26th inst" and inserting in lieu thereof, the words "Tuesday the 22d inst." and the question

was put and determined in the negative.

Mr. Forrest moved to amend the message by striking out the following words; "and the Senate therefore respectfully propose Saturday the 26th inst. as the day of final adjournment," and, the question was put and determined in the negative.

The question was then put, will the Senate assent to the message? Determined in the affirmative. So the message was

assented to.

Mr. Harrison from the committee made a favorable report upon the bill, entitled, an act to incorporate the Port Deposit Library company.

The said bill was then read a second, and by special order

a third time, and passed.

Mr. Forrest from the committee on pensions and revolutionary claims, made a favorable report upon the resolution in favour of Stephen Hafley, a revolutionary soldier—the said resolution was then read a second, and by special order a third time, and assented to.

Mr. Forrest from the same committee made a favorable re-

port upon the resolution in favor of Maria. Gambrill.

The said resolution was then read a second, and by special

order a third time, and assented to.

Mr. Heath from the committee, reported a bill, entitled, an act for the relief of Robert H. Hays, of Cecil county; which was read the first time.

Mr. Thomas from the committee on ways and means, made a favorable report upon the resolution requiring the Commissioners of the School fund for Calvert county, to make an annual report to the Legislature of the manner of distributing said fund.

The said resolution was then read a second, and by special

order a third time, and assented to.

Mr. Dennis from the committee, made a favorable report upon the bill, entitled, a supplement to an act, entitled, an act to provide for the appointment of Commissioners for the regulation and improvement of Princess Anne, in Somerset county, with the following amendment, viz.—

Amendment proposed:

Add to the end of the bill as follows:

"Provided, That nothing in this act shall extend to repeal said act and its supplements with regard to persons residing within one hundred feet from the alley which separates the town of Princess Anne, from the said western precincts, and
