

2. In the 4th line of the 2d section, after the word "of," strike out all the words to the end of the section, and insert in lieu thereof the following words: "each and every barrel, half barrel or tierce, of shad or mackerel fish, ten cents; and for each and every barrel, half barrel or tierce, of herrings, three cents, and no more."

3. In the 6th line of the 3d section, strike out the following words; "to be collected as other small debts are collected."

4. In the 3d line of the 3d section, strike out the words, "the city court of Baltimore," and insert the words "Baltimore city court."

5. Strike out the title of the bill, and insert the following as the title: "An act to reduce the rate of inspection of fish in the city of Baltimore."

Which amendments were read and assented to,

The said bill was then read a second, and by special order a third time, passed with the proposed amendments, and returned to the house of delegates.

On motion of Mr. Forrest, the senate proceeded to take up for consideration the bill, entitled, An additional supplement to the act to prevent the unnecessary accumulation of costs in civil suits,

The bill being on its second reading,

On motion of Mr. Forrest, the bill was amended by inserting after the word "exceptions" in the 3d line of the 1st section, the words "or otherwise."

On motion of Mr. Forrest, the words "excepted to," in the 4th line of the same section, was struck out.

On motion of Mr. Forrest, the last section of the bill was struck out.

The bill having been read throughout and amended, the question was put, Shall the bill as amended be engrossed for a third reading?
