The bill, entitled, A supplement to the act, entitled, An act for founding a college in the city of Frederick, by the name of Frederick College, was read a third time, rejected, and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Kennedy from the committee to which was referred the bill for the relief of Thomas Williams, of Washington county, reported the same without amendment.

The said bill was then read a second, and by special order a third time, rejected, and returned to the house of delegates.

On motion of Mr. Heath, the committee to which was referred the petition of Thomas Maund and Metta H. H. Maund, praying the passage of a law to authorise and empower them to grant leases of the real estate therein mentioned, was discharged from the further consideration of the same.

On motion of Mr. Heath, the committee to which was referred the letter of William League, state wharfinger in the city of Baltimore, were discharged from the further consideration of the same.

Mr. Heath from the committee, made a favourable report upon the bill, entitled, An act for the relief of John Childs, of Anne-Arundel county.

The said bill was then read a second, and by special order a third time, passed, and returned to the house of delegates.
