

cial order a second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

And having been engrossed, was then, on motion of Mr. Forrest, read a third time by special order, passed, and sent to the house of delegates.

Mr. Forrest, from the committee on pensions and revolutionary claims, made an unfavourable report upon the resolution in favour of Catherine Plane, of Anne-Arundel county.

The said resolution was then read a second, and by special order a third time, and after some discussion the question was put, Will the senate assent to the resolution? Determined in the affirmative, and the resolution returned to the house of delegates.

The clerk of the house of delegates delivered a resolution in favour of Isaac Cooper, of Calvert county; which was read the first time and referred to the committee on ways and means.

And returned the bill, entitled, *An act to prevent unnecessary expense and delay in prosecuting appeals from courts exercising equity jurisdiction in this state.*

Also the bill, entitled, *An additional supplement to the act to prevent the unnecessary accumulation of costs in civil suits, severally endorsed, "will pass."* Ordered that the said bills be engrossed.

On motion of Mr. Kennedy, the following order was read and adopted.

Ordered, That the governor and council be, and they are hereby requested, to lay before the senate, their journals for the present year.

Mr. Thomas, from the committee on ways and means, made a favourable report upon the resolution in favour of Isaac Hooper, of Calvert county.

The said resolution was then read a second, and by special order a third time, assented to, and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Forrest asked obtained leave to bring in a bill to be entitled, *An additional supplement to the act of December session 1827, chapter 117, entitled, An act to regulate the issuing of licenses to traders, keepers of ordinaries, and others.* Ordered, That Messrs. Forrest, Smith and Kennedy, be a committee to prepare and report the same.

On motion of Mr. Kennedy, the following report of the
