

On motion of Mr. Pigman, the resolutions relative to the Southern and Western Boundaries of this State, were read the third time by special order and assented to.

Mr. Sappington, from the committee to which it had been referred, reported favorably on the bill, entitled, an act to revive and continue in full force, an act entitled, an act to preserve the side walks in Union-Town, Frederick county, passed at December session, 1830, chapter 2; which was read the second, and by special order the third time and passed.

The Senate adjourned until Monday morning 10 o'clock.

MONDAY, January 9th, 1832.

The Senate met. Present the same members as on Saturday. The proceedings of Saturday were read.

The bill, entitled, an act to revive and continue in full force, an act entitled, an act to preserve the side walks in Union-Town, Frederick county, passed December session, 1830, chapter 2; which was passed by the Senate on Saturday: and the resolution in favor of John Greenwood, also assented to by the Senate on Saturday, were returned to the House of Delegates.

The President laid before the Senate, a letter from Thomas C. Worthington, Esq., a member elect of the Council, accepting the appointment, which was read and referred to the consideration of the House of Delegates.

The clerk of the House of Delegates delivered the following resolution and bill:
