

word "not" at the beginning of the sixth line, insert the words "toll house or toll houses." Between the word "two" and the word "and" in the sixth line of the same section, insert the words, "of each." After the words, "United States" in the seventh line of the thirteen section, insert the words, "to repair the same and to pay the expenses of building a toll-house or toll houses, and erecting a toll-gate or toll gates to be built and erected by the Superintendent appointed by the Governor and Council of this State." In the sixteenth and seventeenth lines of the same section, strike out the words, "the erecting toll-houses and toll gates, and for."

The bill was then read through, and the question was put, "Shall the bill be engrossed for a third reading?"; and it was determined in the affirmative.

The Senate adjourned until to-morrow morning 10 o'clock.

TUESDAY, January 10th, 1832.

The Senate met. Present the same members as on yesterday. The proceedings of yesterday were read.

Mr. Mayer appeared in the Senate chamber.

The communication of the Treasurer of the Western Shore, enclosing a transcript of the report of the managers of the Washington Monument, was sent to the House of Delegates.

The President laid before the Senate, a letter from Robert W. Bowie, Esq., a member elect of the Council, communicating his intention to accept the appointment; which was read and referred to the consideration of the House of Delegates.

Mr. Mayer, presented the petition of James Williams, Jr., of Baltimore, praying for a special act of insolvency; which was read and referred to the committee on insolvency.

Mr. Mayer, from the committee to which it had been referred, reported, that the committee had had the bill, entitled, an act to confirm the proceedings of certain commissioners; and to extend the time for making a road in Baltimore county under consideration, and were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendments:
