

conveyed for the residence and accommodation of a teacher, with the following amendments; which were read and assented to :

After the word, "other," in the fourth line of the preamble, insert the words, "use or purpose."

After the word, "other," in the sixth line of the preamble, insert the word, "purpose;" the bill was then read the second time.

Mr. Dennis, from the committee on invalid Deeds, to which had been referred, a bill, entitled, an act to authorise the clerk of Harford county court to record the deeds therein mentioned.

Also, a bill, entitled, an act to make valid a deed from Abel Pearson and wife to John Andrews, reported, that the committee had had said bills under consideration, and were of opinion they ought not to pass. The said bills were severally read the second time.

Mr. Mayer, from the committee on Judicial proceedings, to which had been referred, a resolution in favor of the Crier of Harford county court, reported, that the committee had had the said resolution under consideration, and were of opinion it ought to be assented to, with the following amendment; which was read and adopted :

After the word, "authorised," in the third line, insert the words, "and directed." The resolution was read the second, and by special order the third time, assented to, and returned to the House of Delegates.

The clerk of the House of Delegates, delivered the following bills :

A bill, entitled, an act to distribute the School Fund of Montgomery county; which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Chapman, Page and Hughlett.

A bill, entitled, a supplement to the act entitled an act, for electing commissioners for Harford county, and prescribing their powers and duties, passed at December session, 1827; which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Montgomery, Sappington and Reid.

A bill, entitled, an act to build a new Bridge over Great Choptank River at Greensborough, in Caroline county; which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Reid, Pigman and Wootton.

The bill, entitled, an act for the preservation and repair of that part of the United States Road, within the limits of the State of Maryland; was read the third time, and on motion of Mr. Montgomery, it was recommitted to Messrs. Pigman, Mayer and Sappington.

The Senate adjourned until to-morrow morning 10 o'clock.
