

A bill, entitled, an act to alter and change the location of part of the second and third election districts in Worcester county, which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Dennis, Emory and Sappington.

A bill, entitled, an act to incorporate the Washington road company of Baltimore, which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Mayer, Montgomery and Reid.

A bill, entitled, an act for the revaluation and re-assessment of the real and personal property in Worcester county, which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Dennis, Osborne and Pigman.

A bill, entitled, an act to authorise the recording of a deed therein mentioned, which was read the first time and referred to the committee on invalid deeds and defective proceedings, and returned the bill, entitled, an additional supplement to the act, entitled, an act to incorporate a company for erecting a bridge over Choptank river, at or near Doyer Ferry, which originated in the Senate, endorsed, will pass.
