was read the third time by special order, and ordered to lie on the table.

The bill entitled, an act for the benefit of the sheriff of

Washington county, was read the third time and passed.

Mr. Mayer from the committee on judicial proceedings to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to repeal an act to abolish imprisonment for debt on certain judgments rendered by justices of the peace, passed at December session 1830, chapter 155, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration, and were of opinion it ought not to pass.

It was then read the second time.

The bill entitled, a supplement to the act entitled, an act to enable purchasers to obtain possession of lands and premises sold by sheriffs, coroners and elisors, at public auction, passed December session 1825, chapter 103, was read the

third time as proposed to be amended, and passed.

Mr. Taney from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to appoint commissioners to fix on a scite for a bridge over Deer Creek, in Harford county, at or near Death's Ford or Wilson's Mill, or at some scite between said places, and to authorise a levy not exceeding one thousand dollars for the purpose of erecting the same, reported favorably thereon.

It was then read the second time.

The Senate adjourned until to morrow morning 10 o'clock.
