red to Messrs. Taney, Dennis and Sappington.

A bill, entitled, an act to provide more effectually for the repairing and re-building of bridges in Baltimore county, and for other purposes: which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Mayer, Taney and Wootton

A bill, entitled, an act to authorise the levy court of Kent county to levy a sum of money therein mentioned to be applied to the enlargement and repair of the house in which the offices of clerk of the court and register of wills of said county are kept and held; which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Emory, Pigman and Hughlett.

And returned the bill which originated in the senate, entitled, A further supplement to the act, entitled, An act to incorporate the Baltimore and Pitston Coal Company, endors-

ed "will pass."

Mr. Taney submitted the following resolution; which was read the first time, to wit:

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That so nuch of the resolution in favour of the heirs of Thomas Parran, a revolutionary soldier, passed at December session 827, number 40, as requires the land granted by said resoution to be located to the westward of Fort Cumberland, e and the same is hereby repealed.
