

The question was then put, "Will the Senate assent to the proposed amendment?"

The bill, was then read through, and the question was put, "Shall the bill pass?"

It was determined in the affirmative.

And the bill was returned to the house of delegates.

On motion of Mr. Mayer,

The bill, entitled, a supplement to the act, entitled, an act to incorporate companies to make several Turnpike Roads through Baltimore county, passed on the 12th of Jan. 1805, chapter 51; was read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Mr Dennis, from the committee on Finance, to which was referred the bill, entitled, a supplement to the act, entitled, an act to provide for the collection of the public revenue, passed at December session, 1829, chapter 90, reported favorably thereon.

It was then read the second time.

The clerk of the House of Delegates delivered the following message :
