election in the second election district of Anne-Arundel cunnty, reported favorably thereon.

It was then read the second, and by special order the

third time and passed.

On motion of Mr. Sappington, leave was given to bring in a bill to be entitled, an act relating to the recording of deeds. Ordered, that Messrs. Sappington, Dennis and Pigman be a committee to prepare and report the same.

On motion of Mr. Wotton, the bill, entitled, an additional supplement to the act to amend the lottery system, was made the order of the day for Friday next, the 3d of February.

Mr. Emory from the committee to which the leave was referred, reported a bill entitled, an act to alter the time of the meeting of the general assembly of this state, and for

other purposes; which was read the first time.

Mr. Mayer from the committee on judicial proceedings to which was referred the bill, entitled, a further supplement to the act, entitled, an act for the dispatch of business in Baltimore county court, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration, and were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendments, which were read and adopted, to wit:

1. In the 7th line, between "court" and "and" insert the following: "and for all such other proceedings and "business as are now authorised by law to be had and transacted at

the county terms of Baltimore county court."

At the end of the bill, add the following sections:

2. And be it enacted, That all city cases in Baltimore county court instituted or that shall be instituted to the terms

for city business, may stand for trial as follows:

That is to say: All cases instituted to May terms, may stand for trial at the succeeding September term; all cases instituted to September term, may stand for trial at the succeeding December term; all cases instituted to December and January terms respectively may stand for trial at the succeeding May term—saving from the operation of this act the cases instituted to the January term of the year eighteen hundred and thirty-two.

And be it enacted, That Baltimore county court may hold the city terms for the trial of causes at such terms for such period beyond the space of time allowed by the law to which this is a supplement as such court may deem proper, and shall be authorised to cause jurors from time to time to be summoned and attend and sworn for the trial of
