Mr. Wootton, from the committee on Internal Improvement, to which was referred the bill, entitled, a supplement to the act, entitled, an act to regulate the manner of obtaining and altering public roads in Baltimore county, passed at December session, 1825, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration, and were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendments, which were read and assented to:

In the 3d line of the 2d section, after the word "straight-on" insert the word "or."

In the same line, after the word, "amend," strike out the words "or otherwise."

In the 4th line, same section, after the word "resignation" insert the word "or."

After the word "refusal" in the same line, strike out the words "or otherwise."

The bill was then read the second, and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr Wootton from the committee to which was referred the bill, entitled, an act for the relief of the heirs and representatives of the late Nicholas Snowden, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration, and were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendments; which were read and assented to.

In the 8d line of the 1st section after the word "bond" insert the following: "which assent shall be in writing, and filed in the orphans court of Prince-George's county."

At the end of the bill add the following section:

"And be it enacted, That said rents and profits for the said term of five years as respects the liability therefor of said administratrix, be deemed and taken to be personal estate of said Nicholas Snowden, and shall be accounted for as such to the orphans court to which as administratrix she may be accountable, and to every effect as to her and her securities in her administration bond shall be taken to be within the condition of said bond."
