

3rd. In the 8th. line of the same section, strike out the words "from time to time."

4th. In the 11th. line of the 2nd. section, strike out the word "personal."

5th. In the 12th. line of the same section, strike out the words "or other" and insert in lieu thereof the words "to the state of Kentucky with."

6th. In the 13th. line of the same section, after the word "Kentucky" insert the word "conditioned."

7th. In the 14th. line in the same section, strike out the words "the said state of Kentucky" and insert the words "the person or persons entitled to receive the same."

8th. In the 13th. line of the same section, strike out the word "personal."

9th. After the word "enacted" in the 1st. line of the 2nd. section, strike out the entire section, and insert the following.

"That any receipt for the payment of the money, or transfer of the property aforesaid, made by any trustee in pursuance of any order or decree in the premises made by Frederick county court, sitting as a court of equity, which shall be acknowledged before any justice of the peace for Frederick county, may be recorded in the clerks office of said county, and that a copy of such receipt, acknowledged and recorded as aforesaid, duly attested, under the seal of the office in which the same shall have been recorded, shall at all times hereafter be admitted as evidence in any court of law or equity in this state, to prove such payment or transfer."

10th. Add as an additional section at the end of the bill the following.

"And be it enacted, That the clerk of Frederick county court, may ask, demand and receive such fee for recording the same as is allowed by law in other cases of a similar nature."

The bill was then read the second, and by special order the third time and passed.

On motion of Mr. Dennis.

The bill entitled, an act to repeal the third section of an act entitled, a further supplement to the act entitled, an act for the relief of sundry insolvent debtors, passed at December session 1830, was ordered to lie on the table.

The senate adjourned until to-morrow morning 10 o'clock
