

THURSDAY, February 9th, 1832.

The Senate met. Present the same members as on yesterday. The proceedings of yesterday were read.

The bill, entitled, an additional supplement to an act, to amend the Lottery system, passed by the Senate on yesterday; was returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Mayer, from the committee, to which was recommit-
ted the bill, entitled, an act to incorporate the People's
Steam Navigation Company; reported favorably thereon.

The bill was then read the second time.

Mr. Mayer, from the committee, to which was referred,
The bill, entitled, an act providing for the Inspection of
Sole Leather, and Rough Harness, and Rough Skirting Lea-
ther, in the city of Baltimore; reported, that the committee
had had said bill under consideration, and were of opinion,
it ought to pass, with the following amendments; which was
read and assented to:

In the 29th line of the 2nd section. strike out the words,
"any due allowance or deduction for such dampness."

In the 6th line of the 12th section, strike out the word,
"deception" and insert the word "decision."

In the 7th line of the 12th section, strike out the word,
"decussion" and insert the word "decision."

The bill was then read the second time.

Mr. Mayer from the committee to which was referred
the bill entitled, an act to incorporate Baer's Chmical
works of Baltimore, reported that the committee had had
said bill under consideration and were of opinion it ought
to pass with the following amendments; which were read
and assented to:

At the end of the 4th. section, strike out the words,
"scire, upon change of party between individuals," and in-
sert "sicre facias upon a change of a party after judgment
in a suit between individuals."

5th. section 5th line, after "hold" insert "within sixty
days thereafter."

At the end of the 5th section add:

"And said directors or a majority of them, or any of them
who shall be and remain a director or directors after any
vacancy or vacancies, shall have power to fill up any vacancy
or vacancies that may occur in their body or in the place of
president, and also to appoint a president pro tempore."
