

then and in that case, the owner or owners of said sheep shall not have cause of action against the owner or owners of said dog or dogs."

Mr. Mayer presented the memorial of William Patterson and others, of Baltimore, relative to the inspection of flour; which was read and referred to Messrs. Mayer, Pigman and Taney.

The bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Mechanics' Institute and Frederick Lyseum, was read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading, and being, accordingly engrossed,

On motion of Mr. Sappington, it was read the third time, passed, and sent to the house of delegates.

On motion of Mr. Mayer, leave was given to bring in a bill to be entitled, a further additional supplement to the act entitled, an act to regulate the inspection of Tobacco.

Ordered, That Messrs. Mayer, Wootton and Claude, be a committee to prepare and report the same.

On motion of Mr. Mayer, leave was given to bring in a bill to be entitled, an act concerning the judgments and judicial proceedings of the courts of justice in this state, and to provide for the completion of the records in certain cases.

Ordered, That the committee on judicial proceedings prepare and report the same.

On motion of Mr. Mayer, leave was given to bring in a bill to be entitled, an act to define and enlarge the powers of the courts of equity.

Ordered, That the committee on Judicial Proceedings prepare and report the same.

On motion of Mr. Mayer, leave was given to bring in a bill to be entitled, an act relating to insolvent debtors.

Ordered, That Messrs. Mayer, Claude and Sappington, be a committee to prepare and report the same.

On motion of Mr. Mayer, leave was given to report a bill to be entitled, an act relating to appeals and writs of error and proceedings in county courts.

Ordered, That the committee on Judicial Proceedings prepare and report the same.

On motion of Mr. Montgomery, leave was given to report a bill to be entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act to authorise the rebuilding of a bridge over Coniwingo Creek, at or near Abijah Fenn's, in Cecil county, passed at the present session.
