A bill, entitled, an act to divorce Henrictta S. Stewart of the city of Baltimore, from her husband James Stewart; which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. May-

er, Montgomery and Wootton.

A hill entitled, an act to enable John Cummins of the state of Delaware, to remove out of this state a negro in whom he possesses an unexpired term; which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Taney, Emory, Dennis, Woot-

ton and Pigman.

Mr. Montgomery from the committee to which was referred the leave, reported a bill entitled, an act supplementary to an act passed at December session 1831, entitled, an act to authorise the re-building of a bridge over Conewingo Creek at or near Abijah Fenn's in Cecil county; which was read the first, and by special order the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

And being accordingly engrossed,

On motion of Mr. Montgomery, it was read the third time by special order, passed, and sent to the house of delegates.

Mr. Mayer presented memorials from House, Woolen and company, and others; and from George Hall and others relative to the inspection of lumber; which were severally read and referred to Messrs. Mayer, Montgomery

and Taney.

Mr. Mayer from the committee to which was recommitted the bill entitled, an act to incorporate Bear's Cheymical Works of Baltimore, reported that the committee had had said bill again under consideration and were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendments; which were read and assented to.

In 2nd section, strike out the third line, and in place thereof insert "other articles of chymical manufacture and preparation."

Strike out the third section, after the enacting clause and insert as follows:

"That the capital stock of said corporation shall not exceed the sum of three hundred thousand dollars, to be divided into shares of one hundred dollars each, and that three persons be appointed by said William Baer, Frederick A. Schley and Michael Baer, or a majority of them, commissioners for receiving subscriptions for said stock, to such amount, not less than ten thousand dollars, as said William Baer, Frederick A. Schley and Michael Baer, or a majority of them shall direct, and said commissioners or a majority
