of them, shall open books for receiving such subscription in the City of Baltimore, on or before the first day of May next, after giving thirty days notice by advertisement inserted twice a week, in at least two newspapers of that city, of the time and place and hours of receiving such subscriptions, and shall keep said books open for such subscriptions, for the space of at least fourteen days, Sundays excluded.

Strike out the fourth section.

5th section, 5th line, after "held," add "within sixty days thereafter."

At the end of the fifth section, add:

"And said directors, or a majority of them, who shall be and remain directors, after any vacancy or vacancies, shall have power to fill up any vacancy or vacancies that may occur in their body, or in the place of President, and also to appoint a President pro tempore, in or for any absence of the permanent President."

At the end of the 6th section, add:

"And the said president and directors, or a majority of them, are hereby authorised to exercise all the powers by this act given to said body corporate."

In the 7th section, strike out all that part beginning with the word "shall" in the third line and ending with the word

"period;" in the sixth line.

At the end of the 7th section, add:

"With all the powers by this act given to President and Directors of said corporation."

The bill was then read the second and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.
