Also the following bills:

A bill entitled, an act for the relief of Mary Keplinger of the city of Baltimore; which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Mayer, Dennis and Sappington.

A bill entitled, an act for the relief of George Baltzell, collector of taxes for Frederick county; which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Sappington, Taney and Montgomery.

A bill entitled, an act to regulate the weight of Quercitron and all other ground bark, Sumach and all other articles sold by weight in this state; which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Wootton, Pigman and Reid.

A bill entitled, an act for the re-valuation of real and personal property in Talbot county; which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Hughlett, Reid and Montgomery.

A bill entitled, a supplement to an act to provide for the purchase of the office papers belonging to the surveyors of the office of Frederick county, and to repeal an act therein mentioned; which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Sappington, Mayer and Pigman.

A bill entitled, an act to repeal all such parts of the constitution and form of government as relate to the division of Frederick county into twelve election districts, and for other purposes; which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Sappington, Taney and Reid.

A bill entitled, an act to authorise the clerk of Washington county court to record the deed therein mentioned; which was read the first time and referred to the committee on the valid deeds.
