Gentlemen of the House of Delegates,

We have received your message proposing a joint committee of both houses to examine into the state of the public business necessary to be acted upon at the present session, with a view to fixing some probable day on which the present session of the legislature may be brought to a close, and concur therein, and we have appointed on the part of the senate Messrs.

to

join the gentlemen named by your honorable body.

Mr. Hughlett from the committee to which the leave was granted, reported a bill entitled, an additional supplement to the act entitled, an act for erecting a bridge over Choptank River, at or near Dover Ferry; which was read the first time.

On motion of Mr. Sappington, the bill entitled, a further supplement to the act entitled, an act to incorporate Frederick Town, in Frederick county, was read the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

The bill entitled, a further supplement to an act entitled, an act to establish a bank and incorporate a company under the name of the Conococheague Bank, in Williamsport, in Washington county, passed at December session 1819, ch. 142, was read the third time, passed and sent to the house of delegates.

Mr. L. Dennis from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to enlarge the Dublin election district in Somerset county, reported favorably thereon.

The bill was then read the second, and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Sappington from the committee on the militia to which was referred a resolution in favor of Henry Korn and Moses E. Louthan, reported favorably thereon.

It was then read the second, and by special order the third time, as sent to, and returned to the house of delegates.

The clerk of the house of delegates delivered the following bills:
