

After the word "oath" in the 7th line of the same section, insert the words "to be settled in said court as a chancery proceeding."

The bill was then read the second, and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

The clerk of the house of delegates delivered the following resolution.

A bill entitled, an act for the benefit of John L. Trundle of Montgomery county; which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Taney, Emory, Dennis, Wootton and Pigman.

A bill entitled, an act to repeal the second section of an act passed at December session 1828, chapter 98; which was read the first time and referred to the committee on finance.

A bill entitled, an act for the regulation and improvement of the village of Denton in Caroline county, and for other purposes; which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Reid, Dennis and Claude.

A bill entitled, an act for the relief of Joseph Larned of the city of Washington; which was read the first time and referred to the committee on insolvency.

A bill entitled, an act for the relief of Elizabeth Finck of Frederick county; which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Sappington, Hughlett and Pigman.

A bill entitled, an act to authorise the justices of the orphans court of Caroline county to appoint their crier; which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Reid, Page and Dennis.

A bill entitled, an act to authorise the levy court of Montgomery county, to levy a sum of money for the purposes therein mentioned; which was read the first time and referred to the committee on internal improvement.
