After the word "oath" in the 7th line of the same section, insert the words "to be settled in said court as a chancery proceeding"

The bill was then read the second, and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the house of dele-

gates.

The clerk of the house of delegates delivered the follow-

A resolution in favor of the adminitrators of Thomas. Stallings, late of Allegany county, deceased; which was read the first time and referred to the committee on finance.

Piginan.

A bill entitled, an act to repeal the second section of an act passed at December session 1828, chapter 98; which was read the first time and referred to the committee on finance.

A bill entitled, an act for the regulation and improvement of the village of Denton in Caroline county, and for other purposes; which was read the first time and referred to Messrs Reid, Dennis and Claude.

A bill entitled, an act for the relief of Joseph Larned of the city of Washington; which was read the first time and referred to the committee on insolvency.

A bill entitled, an act for he relief of Elizabeth Finfrock of Frederick county; which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Sappington, Hughlett and Pigman.

A bill entitled, an act to authorise the justices of the orphans court of Caroline county to appoint their crier; which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Reid, Page and Dennis.
