On motion of Mr. Mayer, it was read the third time by special order and passed.

On motion of Mr. Mayer, the bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Baltimore and Chesapeake Steam Saw Mill Company, was taken up for consideration, and the following amendments read and assented to:

In the 3d section 2d line strike out "one" before the word "thousand" and insert the word "two."

In the 12th line of 4th section between the words "body" and "within" insert the words "or the place of president."

On motion of Mr. Dennis, the amendment heretofore offered by him was withdrawn.

The bill was then read the second, and by special order the third time and passed.

The bill entitled, a supplement to the act entitled, an act concerning the judgments and judicial proceedings of the courts of justice in this state, and to provide for the completion of records in certain cases, passed at December session 1827, chapter 119, was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
