Mr. Montgomery from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, a supplement to the act, entitled, an act for regulating and inspecting weights and measures used in this state, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration, and were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendment; which was read and assented to:

At the end of the 2d section add the following words: 'and the performance of duties prescribed by this act.'

The bill was then read the second, and by special order the third time and passed.

The bill entitled, an act relating to insolvent debtors, being entitled to a second reading, was taken up for consideration, and whilst progressing in the reading,

On motion of Mr. Mayer, the following amendments were read and assented to:

In the 3d line of the 3d section strike out the words 'one year' and insert the words 'six months.'

At the end of the 3d section add the following proviso:

'Provided the commissioners aforesaid or the court or judge to whom the application shall be made, shall be satisfied that such person shall not have come into this state with a view to obtain the benefit of the insolvent laws of this state.'

At the end of the bill add;

"And be it enacted, that for the services performed by the said commissioners by virtue of this act. they shall be entitled to have and receive such compensation as shall be fixed and determined by Baltimore county court."

The bill was then read through the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill, entitled, a further supplement to an act, entitled, an act for amending and reducing into system, the laws and regulations concerning last wills and testaments, the duties of executors, administrators and guardians, and rights of orphan's, and other representatives of deceased persons, was taken up for consideration.

On motion of Mr. Dennis the question was put,

"Shall this bill be referred to the 1st day of October next?"
