

Mr. Mayer from the committee to which was referred, the bill entitled, an act regulating the a admission of attorneys to practice law in the several courts of this state, reported that the committee had said bill under consideration and were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendment; which was read read and assented to.

Strike out the 7th section and insert the following;

Sec. 7. And be it enacted, that if upon the rejection of any applicant for admission to practice law in any county court of this state, such applicant shall deem himself aggrieved by he shall be permitted to apply to the court of such rejection appeals for admission to practice law in said court, who shall examine such applicant as to his qualifications, character and time of studying in manner and subject to the regulation hereinbefore provided as to such examination; and if upon such examination, the court of appeals shall determine that the applicant ought to be admitted to practice in said court of appeals, he shall be admitted accordingly, and such admission shall entitle him to admission to practice in any county court of this state, or in the court of chancery.

The bill was then read the second time.

Mr. Mayer from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to divorce Robert H. Hayes of Cecil county, from his wife Eleanor E. Hayes, reported favorably thereon.

The bill was then read the second time.

The clerk of the house of delegates delivered the following bills.

A bill entitled, a further additional supplement to an act entitled, an act for the revaluation and reassessment of the real and personal estate in Caroline county in this state, passed the present session; which was read the first time and referred to Messrs Reid, Osborne and Hughlett.

A bill entitled, an act for the revaluation of real and personal propeaty in Dorchester county; which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Page, Osborn and Emory.

A bill entitled, an act to prohibit the use of gill nets in the Potomac river, during the period therein mentioned; which was read the first time and referred to Messrs Pigman, Claude and Chapman.

A bill entitled, an act to authorise the commissioners of the tax for Calvert county to levy a sum of money for the repairing or opening a road in said county; which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Page, Sappington and Pigman.
