On motion of Mr. Hughlett, the following amendment was read and assented to:

At the end of the 6th section add the words 'during the continuance of the charter.'

On motion of Mr. Dennis, the following amendment was read and assented to:

Add at the end of the bill the following section:

'And be it enacted, That full power to annul the charter hereby granted is reserved.'

The bill was then read through, and the question was put, "shall the bill pass?" the yeas and nays being asked for, were taken and appeared as follows:
