So it was determined in the affirmative, and the bill was

sent to the house of delegates.

On motion of Mr. Sappington, leave was given to bring in a bill to be entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act to establish a bank and incorporate a company under the name of the Washington county bank at the town of Williamsport, in Washington county.

Ordered, That Messrs Sappington, Mayer and Hugh-

lett, be a committee to prepare and report the same.

Mr. Hughlett from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to divorce Nicholas Connelly Harrison from his wife Mary Harrison, of Talbot county, reported favorably thereon.

The bill was then read the second, and by special order

the third time, and the question was put,

'Shall the bill pass?"

The bill was then read the second, and by special order the third time, passed, and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Mayer from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to provide for opening a part of Parkin street in the city of Baltimore, or closing the same, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration, and were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendments; which were read and assented to.

1st. section 10th line strike out 'the city court of Baltimore' and insert 'Baltimore city court.'
