Mr. Emory from the committee to which was referred the bill, entitled, an act for the further distribution of the donation to the colleges and academies in the several counties of this state, so far as the same relates to Queen Ann's county, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration, and were of opinion it ought to pass, with the following amendment, which was read and assented to.
